Co-payment waivers.

In accordance with Section 1002.84(8), F.S., the coalition may waive the parent co-payment on a case-by-case basis. Each coalition must include a list of qualifying events in its coalition plan and outline the procedure for obtaining a waiver of a co-payment. Requests for the co-payment waivers shall be documented in the case file during the initial authorization for care and at each redetermination.

- (a) At-risk co-payment waivers. A co-payment may be waived on a case-by-case basis for families participating in an at-risk program as defined in Section 1002.81(1), F.S.
- (b) Temporary co-payment waivers. A co-payment may be temporarily waived on a case-by-case basis for families with income at or below 100 percent of the federal poverty level during an event that limits a parent's ability to pay as defined by Section 1002.84(8), F.S. as approved by the coalition representative.
